General	Designed by Peter Norlin and built in Sweden in 1989, <i>New Sweden</i> is one of the most elegant Moderns around. With her modern winged keel, excellent hull shape and generous sail area she is extremely quick, especially in medium to lighter airs. In 2006 she had an excellent racing season, winning both the Royal Southern Yacht Club 6M Regatta and the RYS Household Div Regatta off Cowes, where in 2007 the 6M Worlds and Centenary Metre Regatta will be held, hosted by the RYS (see attached Welcome Letter and NOR).
Sails	Comprehensive wardrobe, including new in 2006, Mainsail, No 1 genoa and 2 spinnakers, plus substantial wardrobe of previous sails suitable for club racing/training etc.
Instrumentation	Fitted 2006 complete Tack Tick system, including full wind instruments, Fluxgate compass, repeaters, etc. Speed and depth.
Hydraulics	Navtec panel controlling hydraulic adjusted forestay and fore and aft mast ram.
Rigging	Most running rigging replaced 2006. Rod standing rigging. New Spectra runner tails 2006.
Spars	Swedish mast and boom, aluminium. Carbon spinnaker pole, new 2006.
Winches	3 x halyard. 2 x 3 speed genoa/spi., incl. underdeck action 2 x runners. 1 x main sheet.
Deck gear	Harken

New Sweden is in commission in Lymington and available immediately, ready for 6M Nationals and Metre Centenary Regatta, Cowes 2007, plus comprehensive International 6M programme 2007.
